

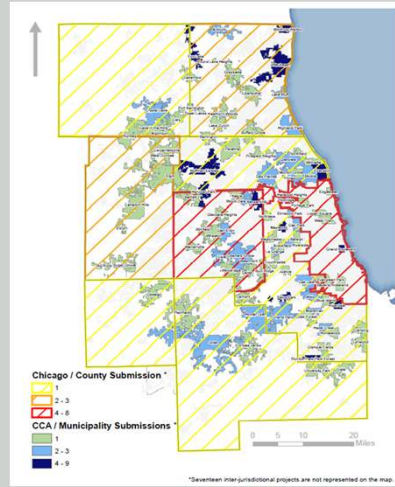
Sustainable Communities Regional Planning Grant

- **October 2010** - HUD awards CMAP \$4.25 million
- **Dec 2010** - CMAP creates Local Technical Assistance (LTA) program LTA program to advance **GO TO 2040** initiative
- **January 2011** - 130 applications with over 220 projects received
- **April 2011** - 64 projects awarded grant for CMAP LTA services (22 project underway)
