


Plan updated in 2008 to meet the nine criteria for a Watershed Based Action Plan.

Creek watershed plan in 2007.





The Conservation Foundation has been leading local efforts in the DuPage River Watershed since 1989.








TCF and Watershed Planning Salt Creek (DuPage)
